**P.E.A.R.L.S. Mentoring for Girls Inc.
Guidelines and Contract for Mentees: Social Media**

As you begin participation into our organization, P.E.A.R.L.S. Mentoring for Girls, Inc. wants to make sure you are aware of our social networking guidelines. The P.E.A.R.L.S. Mentoring for Girls, Inc. recognize and support our PEARLS’ rights to freedom of speech, expression, and association, including the use of social networks. In this context, however, each PEARL must remember that participating in P.E.A.R.L.S. Organization is a privilege. As a PEARL, you represent our organization and you are expected to portray yourself, your PEARLS Sisters, your chapter and the community in a positive manner at all times.

Below are the social networking guidelines which provide the following direction for social networking site usage:

- Everything you post is public information – any text or photo placed online is completely out of your control the moment it is placed online – even if you limit access to your site. Information (including pictures, videos, and comments) may be accessible even after you remove it. Once you post a photo or comment on a social networking site, that photo or comment becomes the property of the site and may be searchable even after you remove it.
- What you post may affect your future! Many employers and college admissions officers review social networking sites as part of their overall evaluation of an applicant. Carefully consider how you want people to perceive you before you give them a chance to misinterpret your information (including pictures, videos, comments and posters).
- Similar to comments made in person, P.E.A.R.L.S. Mentoring for Girls, Inc. will not tolerate disrespectful comments and behavior online, such as:
 - Derogatory language or remarks that may harm your PEARLS Sisters or advisors; other peers, faculty or staff; and community officials or citizens; including comments that may be disrespectful to anyone else.
 - Incriminating photos or statements depicting violence, hazing; sexual harassment; full or partial nudity; inappropriate gestures; vandalism; stalking; underage drinking, selling, possessing, or using controlled substances; or any other inappropriate behavior (including the use of profanity).
 - Creating a serious danger to the safety of another person or making a credible threat of serious physical or emotional injury to another person.

Social media outlets will be used as communication device. They will also be used to encourage involvement with family, friends, supporters, colleges and recruiting outlets. Do not be afraid to retweet and “Like” so we can promote all three sites. For this reason all P.E.A.R.L.S. need to comply with the following:

1. Follow @pearlsm4g on Twitter and @pearls4eg on Instagram as well as allow P.E.A.R.L.S. Mentoring for Girls to follow you.
2. “Like” P.E.A.R.L.S. Mentoring for Girls, Inc. on Facebook.
3. Sign up for emails though our website at www.pearlsmentoring4girls.org
4. Never involve yourself with alcohol or any other controlled substance. Posting pictures, retweeting or “liking” a post where this behavior is going on also indicates your approval.
5. If you are asked to remove a post, you must do so immediately! This is for the protection of your reputation and that of P.E.A.R.L.S. Mentoring for Girls, Inc.

In short, do not have a false sense of security about your rights to freedom of speech. Understand that freedom of speech is not unlimited. The online social network sites are NOT a place where you can say and do whatever you want without repercussions. The information you post on a social networking site is considered public information. Think about who you represent: yourself, your family, P.E.A.R.L.S. Sisters and Mentors, and P.E.A.R.L.S. Mentoring for Girls, Inc. Like it or not, people are going to associate everything you post with you and what you represent. Protect yourself by maintaining a self-image of which you can be proud for years to come.
